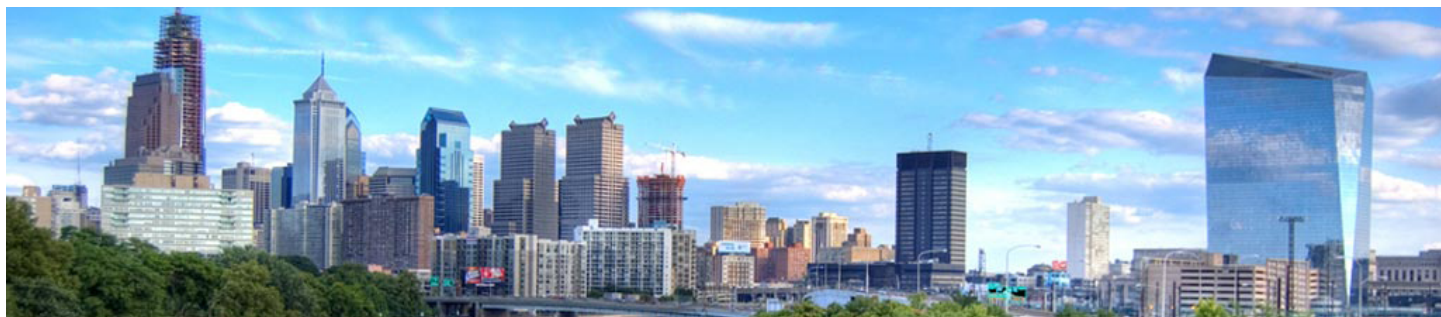


# Join us at the 2019
